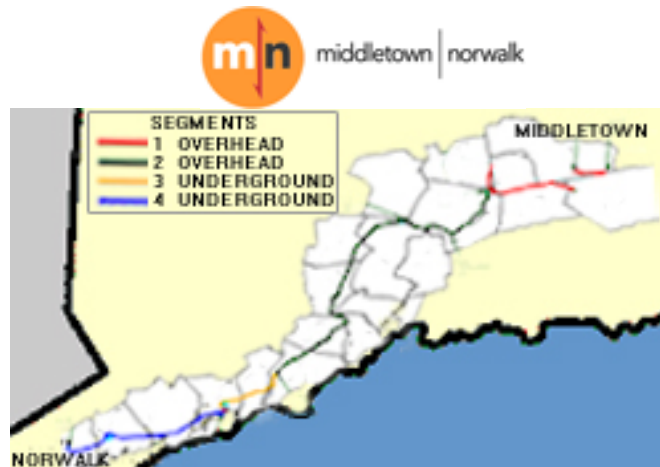

DESCRIPTION OF WORK	
<p>A joint effort between CL&P and UI, the project consists of 69 miles of 345-kilovolt (kV) high voltage transmission lines through 18 Connecticut cities and towns. Spanning seven-and-one-half years, the project completes a loop linking the southwest part of the state to the nearly 400 miles of 345-kV lines that already run through the rest of Connecticut.</p> <p>Construction of the M-N project included 45 miles of overhead lines and 24 miles of underground lines, along with 57 miles of reconstructed 115-kV lines.</p> <p>The project finished early and is expected to cost approximately \$1.27 billion, significantly under budget.</p> <p>McPhee also constructed the new Singer Substation in Bridgeport, CT as part of this overall upgrade project.</p>
