



## Garden State Parkway Shoulder Improvements

As part of the improvements to the Garden State Parkway, the New Jersey Turnpike Transit Authority built full-width shoulders from interchanges 83 through 100 in Monmouth and Ocean Counties. Sight distances were improved and obstructions eliminated. This section of road previously had a reduced speed limit because of safety concerns. McPhee Electric's team upgraded JCP&L 34.5kV circuits to 115kV construction on steel poles crossing the Garden State Parkway as part of the hurricane evacuation route upgrades. The 12.5kV circuits were also upgraded at the same locations.
