Downstream Casino Resort brings a Las Vegas style entertainment experience to the midwest. The resort offers new ways to play that are influenced by the rich history of the Native American culture.

The construction of the Quapaw Tribe's casino resort included:

- 70,000 sq. ft. Las Vegas style casino
- 12-story, 212 room hotel
- Five restaurants
- Live stage performance theater
- World-class, full-service spa, salon, and fitness center
- World's first installation of a Kinetic Color Graze system on the hotel's exterior
- Installation of a 300kVA and a 400kVA uninterruptible power supply
- Installation of two, 4,000A 277/480V service entrances
- Installation of 2 MW of emergency power
- Construction of cellular floor system for gaming power and data
- Installation of complete tele/data system throughout the casino, hotel, and back-of-house, inclusive of data for gaming
- Construction of sound and fire alarm system
